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Plural	1 <sup>st</sup>	-mus
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	-tis
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	-nt

## PERFECT ACTIVE SUBJUNCTIVE

PfS = Perfect Stem (formed by dropping the -i from the 1<sup>st</sup> person singular perfect active indicative form of the verb -- learned as a vocabulary item)
