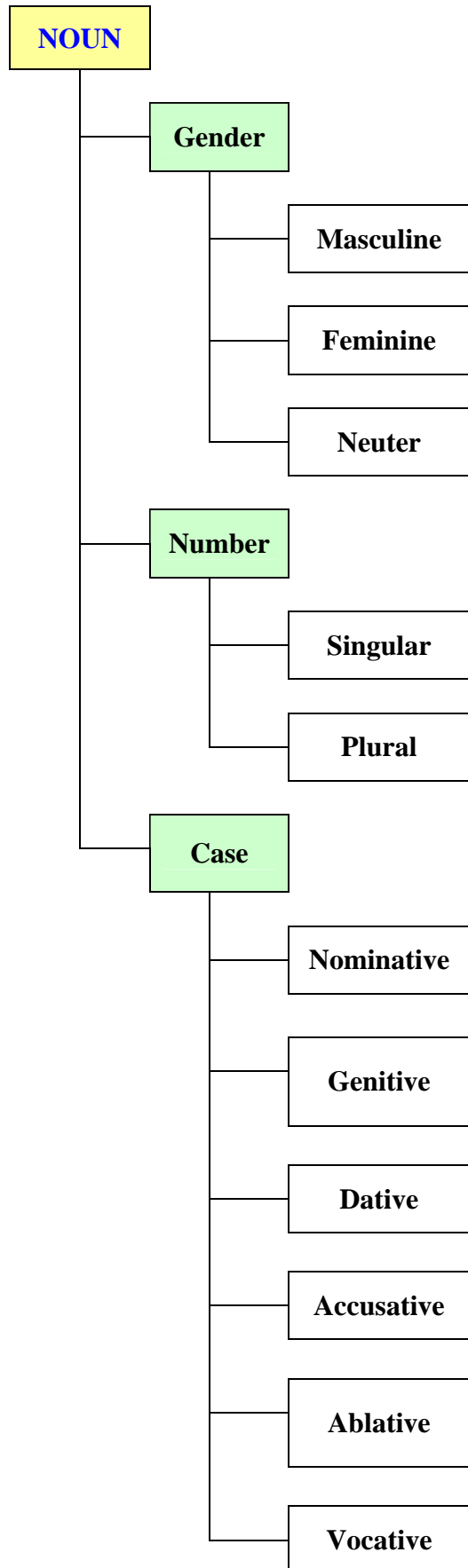


LATIN NOUNS



A noun's *case inflection* (or declension) indicates its use in a sentence:

- Is it the subject?
- Does it belong to another noun (used to show possession)?
- Is it the indirect object?
- Is it the direct object?
- Is it being used in a prepositional phrase?
- Is it being directly addressed?
