

## Formation of the Future Passive Indicative (Conjugations 1, 2, 3 and 4)

### Endings for the Passive Voice (All Conjugations)

	Person	Endings
Singular	1 <sup>st</sup>	-or <i>or</i> -r *
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	-ris (-re)
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	-tur
Plural	1 <sup>st</sup>	-mur
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	-mini
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	-ntur

## FUTURE PASSIVE INDICATIVE

PS = Present Stem (formed by dropping the -re from the infinitive form of the verb)

**NOTA BENE:** In the 2<sup>nd</sup> person singular, conjugations 1 and 2, the normal tense sign of -bi- become -be- before the -ris ending!
